

## **TDT - Texas License To Carry (LTC/CHL) --- Before You Arrive**

### **VERY Important ... Read & Understand**

NOTE: This is NOT a “Learn To Shoot” class ... it is a licensing class, as required by the State of Texas to obtain your Texas LTC. It is understood that you will have a basic proficiency with your firearm before you arrive at the range! If you desire or require a private “Learn To Shoot” session can be arranged prior to this class date. Failure to demonstrate basic shooting skills will result in failure to pass range qualification and result in a shooting qualification retake.

NOTE: Range qualification is a dynamic part of this class ... Each student should arrive with a well maintained firearm (min .22 Cal.) that you are comfortable with. This firearm does not have to be the firearm you plan to carry, and it does not have to be a firearm that you own! (Rentals are also available - \$25, not including ammo ... and must be reserved in advance).

Note ... Be on the range by 8:45, Class will began at 9am (unless otherwise noted).

Note ... Unless informed otherwise this class is a working lunch ... Bring Your Sack Lunch!

Note ... IF possibility of inclement weather - Verify Class The Day Before - We Will NOT Contact You! In the event of a rainout or other severe weather happening, prepaids will be honored at any future class date.

Note ... Find A Printable Map To The Range At Our Website --- [Tac-Def-Tx.com](http://Tac-Def-Tx.com) (Do NOT use your GPS for directions to the range, they will direct you to a wrong location.)

## TDT - Texas License To Carry (LTC/CHL) --- License Eligibility

### ELIGIBILITY

- You must be 21 (18 for active duty military) years of age when TDPS receives your application.
- If you are a citizen of another country you must have a US resident visa.
- If you have a felony conviction with deferred adjudication you must wait 10 years - unless the charge is for an offense against people, including homicide, kidnapping, restraint, human trafficking, sex offenses, assault or robbery. (in which case, don't waste your time)
- You may not have been convicted of a Class A or B misdemeanor within the past 5 years.
- You may not have been convicted of the Class C misdemeanor for disorderly conduct in the past 5 years.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on any student loan.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on any state or city taxes.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on child support.
- You may not presently be charged with a 1) Felony; 2) Class A or B misdemeanor; 3) Class C Disorderly Conduct.
- You may not be currently under a court protective order or subject to a restraining order affecting the spousal relationship, other than a restraining order solely affecting property interest.
- You may not (in the last 10 years preceding the date of application) have been adjudicated as having engaged in delinquent conduct violating a penal law of the grade of felony as a juvenile.
- You cannot have made any material misrepresentation, or failed to disclose any material fact, in an application submitted to DPS.
- You cannot have been convicted twice within the last 10 years for any Class B misdemeanor, or greater, involving the use of alcohol or a controlled substance.
- You cannot be a fugitive from justice; a chemically dependent person;
- You cannot be physical unable or a person of unsound mind as defined by TPC 49.01

## **TDT - Texas License To Carry (LTC/CHL) --- Gear Necessary & Critical Info**

### ***VERY Important ... Read & Understand***

- 1) Handgun – Min .22 cal. (As of 09/2017), NO magnum rounds ... (it is not required to be the pistol you plan to carry, or even one that you own).
- 2) Either Semi-auto Or Revolver (NO derringers, NO rifle round handguns, NO SBR's).
- 3) No Optic Enhancers Activated (Including Lasers, Red Dot, Scopes, etc.)
- 4) Minimum 50 Rounds Of Factory Target Ammo, NO reloads.
- 5) Eye & Ear Protection (Sun Glasses or Eye Glasses Will Suffice --- Muffs or Plugs).
- 6) Dress Accordingly For The Weather (Ball Cap, Sun Screen, Jacket, Light Rain Poncho).
- 7) Notepad & Black Ink Pen.
- 8) Do NOT Pre-Load Any Magazines Or Your Firearm ... You Will Be Instructed On What To Load And When To Load.
- 9) Be On The Range Minimum 15 Minutes Prior To Class - Start Time Is 9am (unless otherwise noted).
- 10) Leave Your “Unloaded” Firearm In Your Vehicle – Do NOT Preload Your Weapon Or Mags.
- 11) Normal Class Duration Is Between 5 and 6 Hours.
