



Texas License to Carry – Before You Arrive Packet

NOTE: This is NOT a “Learn to Shoot” class ... it is a licensing class, as required by the State of Texas to obtain your Texas LTC. It is understood that you **will** have a basic proficiency with your firearm before you arrive at the range! If you desire or require a private “Learn to Shoot” session can be arranged prior to this class date.

Range qualification is a dynamic part of this class ... Each student should arrive with a well-maintained firearm (min .22 Cal.) that you are comfortable with. This firearm does not have to be the firearm you plan to carry, and it does not have to be a firearm that you own! (Rentals are also available - \$25, including ammo ... and must be reserved in advance. **Also, should you have 3 malfunctions during the qualification you WILL be REQUIRED to use one of our firearms and be asked to pay the fee stated above.)**

Please arrive by **8:45**, Class will begin at 9:00 sharp!

Bring your lunch as you will eat during classroom instruction.

RAIN or SHINE class will always happen. Should the weather be too bad, we will continue the classroom portion and reschedule the range qualification!

TX LTC Eligibility

- You must be 21 (18 for active duty military) years of age when TDPS receives your application.
- If you are a citizen of another country you must have a US resident visa.
- If you have a felony conviction with deferred adjudication you must wait 10 years - unless the charge is for an offense against people, including homicide, kidnapping, restraint, human trafficking, sex offenses, assault or robbery. (in which case, don't waste your time)
- You may not have been convicted of a Class A or B misdemeanor within the past 5 years.
- You may not have been convicted of the Class C misdemeanor for disorderly conduct in the past 5 years.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on any student loan.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on any state or city taxes.
- You may not have been found by a court to be currently in default on child support.
- You may not presently be charged with a 1) Felony; 2) Class A or B misdemeanor; 3) Class C Disorderly Conduct.
- You may not be currently under a court protective order or subject to a restraining order affecting the spousal relationship, other than a restraining order solely affecting property interest.
- You cannot have made any material misrepresentation, or failed to disclose any material fact, in an application submitted to DPS.
- You cannot have been convicted twice within the last 10 years for any Class B misdemeanor, or greater, involving the use of alcohol or a controlled substance.
- You cannot be a fugitive from justice; a chemically dependent person; be physical unable or a person of unsound mind as defined by TPC 49.01

TDT - Texas License to Carry (LTC/CHL) - *Gear Necessary & Critical Info*

- 1) Well-maintained Handgun – Min .22 caliber (it is not required to be the pistol you plan to carry, or even one that you own. **Should you have 3 malfunctions during the qualification you WILL be REQUIRED to use one of our firearms and be asked to pay a rental/ammo fee.** If you don't have access to a firearm, you can rent one of ours. The cost is \$25, which includes the 50-rounds ammo. Please let us know PRIOR to the class if you need to rent a firearm.)
- 2) Either Semi-auto Or Revolver (NO derringers, NO rifle round handguns, NO SBR's).
- 3) No Optic Enhancers Activated (Including Lasers, Red Dot, Scopes, etc.)
- 4) Minimum 50 Rounds of Factory Target Ammo... NO reloads, NO magnum rounds.
- 5) Eye & Ear Protection (Sunglasses or Eyeglasses Will Suffice --- Muffs or Plugs).
- 6) Dress Accordingly for The Weather (Ball Cap, Sunscreen, Jacket, Light Rain Poncho, shoes you don't mind getting dirty or wet).
- 7) Notepad & Black Ink Pen.
- 8) Do **NOT** Pre-Load Any Magazines or Your Firearm ... You Will Be Instructed on What to Load And When to Load during the qualification.
- 9) Leave Your "**Unloaded**" Firearm in Your Vehicle.
- 10) Class time required is 4 to 6 hours plus range time. Most classes end no later than 3pm.

Range Location and Map:

We are located at 879 VZ CO RD 1308 Canton, TX 75103.

The exit number is 533 – Oakland/Colfax Rd which is 6 miles east of the HWY 19 exit. You can use Apple, Google or Waze to get to us... search 'Tactical & Defensive of Texas' and we should pop up!

We are 1 mile off the highway. **Look for the TDT sign and a white mailbox that says Berry at the driveway entry!**

Pull into the driveway and come past the house through the second gate.
